### **WERE YOU SELECTED FOR VERIFICATION?**

We send out text alerts and emails at noreply@fsw.edu. Remember to always check your student email!

Yes, I was selected.

### WHAT IS VERIFICATION?

Verification is required by the Department of Education for one of two reasons:

- 1. There is information missing on your FAFSA.
- 2. Your student status needs to be reviewed by a financial aid specialist. This is usually the case for students who are unable to provide parent information.

## No, I was not selected.

- 1. Go to fsw.studentforms.com
- 2. Login with your student portal info
- 3. Confirm personal info
- \*\*\*Your name must be the same as it was on your FAFSA!
- 4. Complete all forms and submit as soon as possible. They must be reviewed manually, so don't wait till the last minute to submit! Otherwise, we cannot guarantee your aid will be in place for the start of the semester.
- 5. If you are unsure about anything, reach out to your Financial Aid Office!



### **WHAT IS COST OF ATTENDANCE?**

Think of Cost of Attendance as a guide to what you *might* pay while attending school. It is not exactly what you *will* pay. We recommend creating a budget for your school year expenses. Talk to the financial aid office about other costs you may encounter while at school.



### **FEDERAL & STATE GRANTS**

The amount you see is the total amount you *could* receive for the school year. Grants usually award for two semesters a school year (1/2 the amount for one semester, 1/2 for the other semester).

Your award is dependent on your enrollment. If you are enrolled in at least 12 credit hours, you will get the full amount. If you are only enrolled part-time, you get only 1/2 of that amount.

Example: \$6000 for the school year, \$3000 for being enrolled in 12+ credit hours a semester, \$1500 for 6-8 credit hours a semester.

The Pell Grant can award for three semesters a school year! Talk to a Financial Aid Specialist about your enrollment plans and how to make the most out of your grant.
