OBOC GPS REQUIREMENT FOR CORNERSTONE STUDENTS

NOTE: If the times of those OBOC events do not work for you, below are options to complete the GPS requirement for an OBOC activity at a time convenient for you.

OPTION 1

Access a digitized version of the book by going to FSW's eReserves and downloading the MyDocs app, or click here: https://researchguides.fsw.edu/eReserves and follow the instructions on the website.

Read at least one of the nine chapters in the book. Create a slide that shows how that chapter impacts you. Clearly indicate at the top of the slide what chapter you read. Find an image related to the topic or message of the chapter (properly cite the image). Then create 3-5 bullets that indicates your analysis of what you read (not a summary). Your bullet points can indicate agreement or disagreement, but should clearly indicate how the reading relates to your experiences, situation, or perspectives.

OPTION 2

Watch one of the 3 videos below, both are related to Gladwell's book. Create a slide that shows how you engaged with the video. Find an image related to the topic or message of the video (properly cite the image). Then create 3-5 bullets that indicates your analysis of the video. Your bullet points can indicate agreement or disagreement, but should clearly indicate how the video compares to your experiences, situation, or perspectives.
