

TEACHER CANDIDATE LEARNING OBJECTIVES

A learning objective is a measurable goal that you set for yourself to be accomplished through your work experience. It will require that you **learn** a new skill, **develop** a new habit and **gain** new information.

A Learning Objective is:

- 1. **Understandable**: Written in clear, simple language, which communicates the meaning to all interested parties.
- 2. Challenging: Difficult enough to stimulate interest and be worthy of college credit.
- 3. Achievable: Capable of being accomplished within the prescribed period of time (one semester).
- 4. Measurable: Specific enough to provide for the observation and verification of accomplishment.

For each objective you should be able to answer the following questions:

- · What are you planning to achieve?
- · Why are you going to achieve this?
- · How do you intend to accomplish this?
- · How will completion of the Objective be measured?
- · What will the end result be?
