## Building S - Taeni Student Services Hall

Taeni Hall is home to many important Student Services departments, the Bookstore, and The Pier Eatery. Key departments include Admissions, Financial Aid, Financial Services, Veterans Services, Registration and Records, and Student Transitions.



## Building U - Classroom Building

Building U is the home of our **School of Education**, classrooms, and a multipurpose room often used for campus events.



## Building W - LightHouse Commons

LightHouse Commons is our student housing community at FSW. Each apartment features private bedrooms, a kitchen, seating area, washer and dryer in unit, and a living area shared with roommates. The complex has 24-hour onsite professional personnel and public safety, a pool open to all FSW students, a fitness center, basketball courts, and a volleyball court.



## Building Q - Howard Hall

Howard Hall houses Student Engagement, Adaptive Services, and the Care Pantry on the first floor. Our Career Connections Center and Workforce Education offices are located on the second floor.



## Building P - Areca Hall

Areca Hall houses a lecture hall on the first floor, and the second floor houses the FSW Testing Services Center.



## Building J - Richard H. Rush Library

On the first floor of the library, we have an auditorium and the Rush Renaissance Gallery. On the second floor, we have Dunkin' Donuts, the Library Help Desk, computer labs, and our Tutoring Centers. The third floor of the library is the study floor, where you can find study rooms to reserve and the honors program lounge.



## Building M - Barbara B. Mann Performance Hall

As a 1,874-seat facility, the Performance Art Hall at FSW features the largest stage in Southwest Florida and presents National Touring Broadway musicals, entertainers, dance performances, and more.




## Inspiration Gardens

### Building L - Humanities Hall (Currently Closed for Rennovation)

### Building K - Hendry Hall

### Buildings A&AA - Nursing and Allied Health Buildings

### Building B - Gresham Hall
